

Four Steps

- STEP 1. Write 15–30 minutes daily
- STEP 2. Record and share daily
- STEP 3. Write informally from the first day of your research project.
- STEP 4. Outline based on an exemplar.

STEP 1. Write 15–30 minutes daily



Writing daily by the numbers

- ❖ 2.7X as many pages and ms.
- From 2 ms./year to almost six
- And all this by writing30 minutes/day, 4 days/week
- And the papers were better!






